## **Fr. John's Christmas Message**

In the gospel passage for Mass Christmas night we hear the Christmas story from the Gospel of Luke. It is a story so simple that even the youngest child can grasp it; yet, even after more than 2000 years, it is a mystery so profound that the richness of its meaning remains inexhaustible. Christ is born of Mary so that He might live in us. We who accept Jesus, who became flesh, become the children of God, not by natural generation but by divine grace. The good news of Christmas will not be fully realized until we can say with Saint Paul: "I live, no longer as myself, but Christ lives in me" (Gal 2:20).

Sometimes people tell me they are afraid of God, yet when we look at Jesus Christ as a child in a manger: Who can be afraid of such a God? Mary, caring loving for her child, becomes the icon of the care that God wants us to extend to every human being, especially the most needy and vulnerable. In truth, our caring for others is care extended to Christ himself.

This Christmas I hope all may truly feel the Christmas spirit: May it guide our work and lives throughout the year. In the darkness of the night, the Christ child shines out as a wonderful light beckoning all of us to realise our full potential in God's plan. I wish each one of you a merry Christmas and may this New Year 2010 be filled with bright promise and many blessings. AMEN
