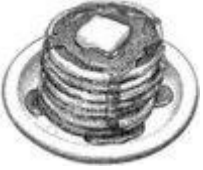

Reflection

Lk 1:1-4, 4:14-21

Pity Christ. He had made just the front page of the Capernaum Examiner. At least, his name was on everyone's lips as a miracle worker and as a great preacher. He went back home to Nazareth. The locals would accept his miracles but not his preaching. Wasn't he one of their own? How could he have anything important to say to them? Didn't they know as much as he? Sure, his parents weren't educated either! They could not hear because they knew Christ so long.

Has your husband or wife been trying to tell you something important and you have not heard because you know him or her so long? It is amazing how the truth can come to us. It comes through a child, a parent, a friend, a neighbor, a colleague on the job. Truth comes from God. God's messenger may be so ordinary and so well known that we ignore his message unwittingly. To hear the truth, to listen to it, to take it to heart can be difficult but is an essential step on the road to happiness and to God.
